SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The **Lakes 8 Conference** selected **Chad Brandow** as Boys Track **Coach of the Year**.

Coach **Brad Busscher** was named **Regional** Coach of the Year for Girls Tennis.

Nicole Bayle was selected **Lakes 8 Volleyball** Coach of the Year.

Courtney McRobert was selected **Coastal Conference Competitive Cheer Coach of the Year**.

The **Boys Track** team won their second consecutive **GMAA track championship** in school history.

Two boys track records were broken this year. **Noah Hendricks** (Jr.) set the new school record of 1:57.4 in the 800 m run. **Nick Kramer** (Jr.) set a new record for the discus with a throw of 166'9".

Sophomore **Iyanna Brown** (Girls basketball) now holds the season average scoring record (18.7 ppg) and junior **Alyssa Veihl** broke the season rebounding record (213).

Fruitport Hosted MHSAA districts in girls' soccer, and the GMAA "city" track meet. We also hosted invitational tournaments in Boys and Girls Tennis, Girls Golf, Volleyball, Bowling, Wrestling, Competitive Cheer, and Softball.

The **Fruitport Athletic Foundation** issued over \$15,000 in coach and athletic department grants for 15-16.

Eleven athletes received the Athletic Foundation's **Outstanding Achievement Award** for receiving 6 or more Varsity letters in a four year career.

The **Fruitport Hall** of Fame inducted its third class in March. The banquet had nearly 300 attendees.
