GRADUATION HONORS

Fruitport High School is pleased to take notice of academic achievements of its seniors each spring. These honors are based on the cumulative grade point average (G.P.A.) of each student earned over their high school career **through the end of the 1st semester of their senior year**. Seniors will be recognized as follows:

Special recognition of Senior Scholars includes press releases, graduation program highlights, honors assembly presentations and the wearing of a medallion in honor of their senior scholar status, purple cowl and honor cords.

Those students who have reached Summa Cum Laude status, will receive a purple cowl which is symbolic of this honor as well as gold honor cords. They will be recognized in the graduation program as well.

Students who have reached Magna Cum Laude and Cum Laude status will receive gold honor cords to recognize their accomplishment.

Honor Roll students will receive recognition in the graduation program.

Excellence in Education students are chosen strictly on their cumulative G.P.A. through the end of the 1st semester of their senior year. These students are the top 10% of the graduating class. This honor includes a luncheon with a selected educator/mentor.

**If SAT test is taken at an off-site location and a higher score is achieved, it is the responsibility of the student to turn a copy of that score to their school counselor no later than the end of 1st semester of their graduating year.
