Over the summer we have had many staff involved in the development of our **Return to School Plan**. The following options are available if we return to school in Phase 4 of Governor Whitmer's plan to reopen the state. If we go to Phase 3 or lower, school will be closed and parents and students will be notified on how remote learning will take place. Additionally, if we go to Phase 5, parents and students will be notified to any changes that would move us closer to what a normal school day would look like.

To assist the district with staffing decisions, we hope to have all students enrolled in either **option #1** or **option #2** by August 14, 2020. We will keep all students enrolled in face-to-face instruction unless you complete the online learning application linked at the bottom of Option #2.



Option #1 **Face-to-Face**

- ◆ Elementary students will report to a normal school day. Masks will be required and social distancing will be attempted in every aspect of the school day. Students will experience the normal curriculum.
- ◆ Secondary students will have a hybrid schedule. Half of the students will report to school for a normal school day on Mondays and Thursdays. The remaining students will report to school on Tuesdays and Fridays. For the days of the week students are not attending school face-to-face, instruction will be delivered online under the direction of the students' teachers.



Option #2 **100% Virtual**

- ◆ The district will soon decide between Edgenuity and Edmentum as the vendor for the elementary virtual program. Parents will be expected to provide support for student learning. Students must remain in this option for an entire semester and can return to face-to-face instruction at the beginning of the second semester.
- ◆ The vendor for students in grades 6-12 will be Odysseyware, though some high school students may elect to take courses through Michigan Virtual University. Students can return to face-to-face instruction at the beginning of the second semester.
- ◆ Students will receive instruction from the online program and get support from a certified teacher assigned through FCS.
