## **MEETING MINUTES**

- 1. Overnight Field Trip Request: Michigan Youth in Government (MYIG) An overnight field trip request from Deeann Skov, high school teacher and MYIG advisor, was discussed. Students will travel to East Lansing/Lansing on February 20-23, 2025, where they will participate in a mock legislative session at the State Capitol. Costs are covered through a MYIG grant, with additional funds from students, families, and the District.
- 2. Office for Civil Rights (OCR) Complaint Update: Beach Playground The Committee discussed an update to the complaint that was filed against the District alleging that the playground at Beach was not ADA compliant. The District, through its attorney appointed by its insurance company, has responded to the complaint, and is awaiting review by OCR.
- 3. **Insulation Litigation Resolution and Filing Deadline** The Committee discussed an opportunity to participate in a mass action lawsuit against insulin manufacturers and other defendants. A copy of a sample complaint will be shared with Board members once received from Thrun Law Firm. If the Board elects to participate in the mass action lawsuit, it will need to adopt a resolution to do so by November 27, 2024.
- 4. Potential May 2025 Bond Proposition: Update on Edgewood Concept The Committee discussed an update on the potential May 2025 Bond Proposition, and

reviewed a rough draft of a conceptual design of a new Edgewood Elementary school that was designed by Tower-Pinkster.
