

Dual Enrollment and Early College FAQ's

For every college class, the student will be required to:

- 1 - Provide their own transportation.
- 2 - Communicate with the school counselor regarding any changes in your MCC schedule.
- 3 - Communicate with the school counselor if the student is struggling.

If a student does not pass the college course in Dual Enrollment or Early College, with a C or better, then the student will have to repay the school for the course.

College course equivalent to High School course work:

College course worth 2 credits - 1 school day hour - worth 1 high school credit

College course worth 3 credits - 1 school day hour - worth 1 high school credit

College course worth 4 credits - 2 school day hour - worth 2 high school credit

College course worth 5 credits - 2 school day hour - worth 2 high school credit

All college classes counting as high school credits, do not count toward high school GPA, but do count as high school credit.
