❖ All AP students must declare whether or not they intend to take an AP exam in May. To declare their intention students need to complete THIS Google Form by 3:00pm on November 8th. The cost of each test is \$100.00, or \$50.00 for students who qualify for free or reduced lunch. Payment for each exam will be in two installments:

The 1st installment is \$50.00 per exam due by 3:00pm on November 18, 2024 and the 2nd installment of \$50.00 per exam is due by 3:00pm on April 25, 2025.

*For students who receive Free or Reduced lunch, the 1st installment of \$25.00 is due November 18, 2024 and the 2nd installment of \$25.00 will be due by 3:00pm on April 25, 2025. Please note, the College Board imposes a \$40.00 late fee for any test ordered AFTER November 15, 2024. In addition, the College Board imposes a \$40.00 fee for any unused or canceled exam should your student change his/her/their mind and decide NOT to take one of the tests.

*The allowance by the State of Michigan for all students to receive free breakfast and lunch <u>DOES NOT</u> automatically qualify an AP student for a reduced AP Exam fee. To qualify for the reduced fee you MUST submit a 2024-2025 Education Benefits application through the FHS Food Service Department, and have your application approved. To find out if your child qualifies please complete the application using either the <u>Meal Magic Portal</u> or by completing the <u>Education Benefits Form SY 2024-2025</u> and returning it to the high school before October 15, 2024.
