- ❖ All AP students must declare whether or not they intend to take an AP exam in May. The cost of each test is \$100.00, or \$50.00 for students who qualify for free or reduced lunch. Payment for each exam

will be in two installments:

The 1st installment is \$50.00 per exam due by 3:00pm on November 18, 2024 and the 2nd installment of \$50.00 per exam is due by 3:00pm on April 25, 2025.

*For students who receive Free or Reduced lunch, the 1st installment of \$25.00 is due November 18, 2024 and the 2nd installment of \$25.00 will be due by 3:00pm on April 25, 2025. Please note, the College Board imposes a \$40.00 late fee for any test ordered AFTER November 15, 2024. In addition, the College Board imposes a \$40.00 fee for any unused or canceled exam should your student change his/her/their mind and decide NOT to take one of the tests. Payments can be made in the form of cash or check; checks should be made payable to Fruitport High School with AP Exam fee noted in the memo section.
